Sir,

We would like to bring to your kind attention to CEC resolutions submitted by us to you vide our letter dated 26th June 2018.

Sir, we once again reiterate our full support on issues related to organizational growth, targets set by ONGC, safe operations and welfare issues related to our employees.

Since we wrote the letter, in last month we have had three major accidents related to chopper, leakages at unmanned platform and 12" pipeline at Jorhat Asset and a fatal accident at Hazira. All these incidents are of very serious nature.


Sir, during this period CWC has interacted with our officers at offshore, office at Kolkata. We have assured them that ASTO and management are working together to resolve lot of pending issues. We also requested them not to approach outside agencies for redressal of their grievances and approach internal grievance redressal forums as well as ASTO.

However, we would be failing in our duty if we do not share the overall mood of our officers working in field. Sir, the overall mood is one of despondency, officers are feeling let down where they are continuing to work in unsafe conditions, lack of quality PPE, zero field allowances, lack of transparency in transfers and a crumbling infrastructure. Field going officers being hackled for payment of paltry amount of local conveyance, CPP charges, payment of TA for training in off period. Across work centers officers are pointing out regarding lack of quality safety shoes, shrinking overalls and lack of impact resistant gloves etc.

Sir, it is now one month that ASTO had submitted the resolutions passed unanimously by CEC. However, till date we have not got any feedback on actions being taken by management in this regard. We are sure that action must have been initiated by the concerned department but neither there has been any perceptible action at ground level nor we have been informed of any action.

Sir, we once again request your good office to kindly advise the concerned departments to initiate necessary action on the resolutions passed by CEC and let us know if management requires any support from our side.
